 - → In light of what is going on in Nashville with HFI, it's worth pointing out that IDEA is well organized, has been operating for a long time, and is certainly a good candidate for which to target charitable donations.

 - But we're anticipating some major discounts for the Spring convention
 - Also we're \$6K ahead this year, have no significant expenses for the rest of the year and may be seeing another \$9K or so of incoming. So we're actually in pretty good shape for 2021.
 - The reason we're ahead this year is due to expenses that have no taken place due to Covid-19. It's all additional uncertainty.
 - We have a pretty decent buffer right now, so we're not concerned at this point.

 - First a pavilion
 - Now a parking garage (it's warmer)
 - → West Towns is doing more educational activities
 - → CSLT style training can pretty easily be done online
 - → Terry Ludwig has gone through Covid-19
 - → Coles County appears to be meeting a lot, doing polecats, Christmas songs.
 - Meeting in a lighted pavilion, earlier that normal, dismissing earlier than normal.
 - A lot of good camaraderie.
 - → Terry: For a director, virtual meetings over zoom is incredibly difficult
 - → Earl Holtz
 - Kingdons are basically programming each rehearsal
 - 2 hour Tue night program
 - Dan Wessler is still with us from Co, runs warmup and rehearses some material
 - We've had guest speakers, other activities.
 - Northbrook has been inviting anyone from other chapters to join in additional fellowship.
 - → Joe Gurreri
 - Let us know through FB if your chapter is doing events, and we'll spread the word to the rest of the district.
 - → Jeff Bowyer
 - They are ordering some equipment that stands the mask off the face a bit to help with breathing while singing

 - District isn't doing anything dues-wise. However we plan some significant reduction in registration fees at the next convention we stage.

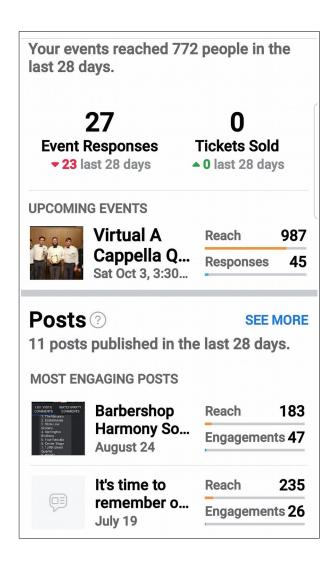
District Facebook page hosted a Watch Party for the announcement of the winners in the Legacy Quartet Competition. It has been recorded and will remain available on the District Facebook page.

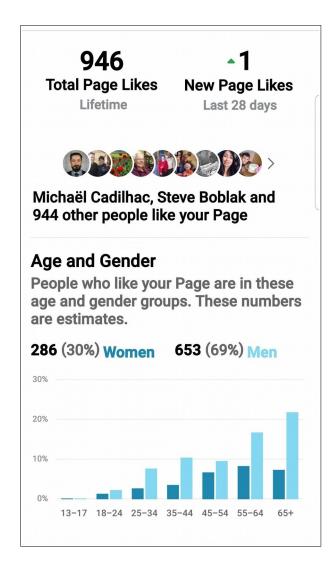

Hello All!

It's been a crazy year to say the least! All of the International Prelims of the BHS were canceled this spring and arrangements were started to provide other ways for quartets to qualify for the 2020 International Convention in Los Angeles. Those plans were short lived as the International Convention was canceled. Six quartets across the Society had qualified for the LA Convention in their respective fall conventions in 2019 (note: IL did not have a qualifying quartet), so those quartets will be able to compete in the 2021 International Convention in Cleveland. In addition, the choruses that qualified for the 2020 Convention in LA will be invited to compete in Cleveland in 2021 as well.

This spring and summer also kept the IL district board busy with decisions. In June, it was decided to cancel the 2020 Fall Convention. Around the same time frame, the rest of the districts of the BHS canceled their conventions as well.

Through much planning and legwork, the IL District has decided to have a Spring Convention in Bloomington, IL on March 19-21, 2021. It will be a full convention with all of our normal quartet and chorus contests. This will include high school, mixed, seniors, men's, choruses, and any other contests we normally have in the fall. There will be district champions named and International qualifiers will punch their ticket to Cleveland.

Now, of course all of this planning is dependent on what conditions the world is in with regard to this virus and the social gathering rules that will be in place next spring. We will definitely keep everyone posted on all the developments as they arise.

Currently, the IL District has no current participants in the judging community within the Society. We do, however, have a candidate judge in the music category. That candidate is DanWessler, bass of After Hours, 2010 IL District Champs and 2018 International Champs. I'm sure Dan will do a fantastic job and we wish him our best.

We hope to see everyone at the Spring Convention on March 19-21, 2021 in Bloomington!!!
