  - Planning to meet in normal rehearsal venue, one director is back from vacation
  - Will be following the church's covid protocol

  - Is a male-only organization
- E007 Bloomington

  - Two women involved now, expect there will be more.
  - Not enough members to put 12 on risers, so unlikely right now to compete
  - Chicago Metro always supports the conventions, probably will send a quartet
  - Did an outdoor concert on April 11<sup>th</sup> (Barbershop Quartet Day)




- Continue to post interesting information and updates, typical with photos and/or video to enhance the algorithm to show on our followers' pages. TAG @illinois district
